Positioned on the edge of parkland in the St Helen's Wood area of Hastings, this remarkable four-bedroom house was built by the current owners and completed in 2009 to a design by BBM Sustainable Design. The house perches atop a hillside plot, overlooking an intriguing garden inspired by the owners' travels through the rainforests of Brazil.


The house, clad in cedar, is located on a quiet no-through road and approached via a gravel driveway with parking space for two cars. Internal accommodation extends to approximately 1,800 sq ft and is arranged over three levels. Entry is to an open-plan ground floor with kitchen, dining area, and living room. Front-facing clerestory windows and floor-to-ceiling glazing across the rear aspect flood the space with natural light. Glazed sliding doors open over the dining area and to a decked balcony, with an eye-level view into the canopy of trees, and to the terrace and garden below.

An oak staircase with steel and glass balustrade ascends to the first floor which comprises the master bedroom with walk-in wardrobe and en-suite shower room.

On the lower ground floor is a utility room, a large bathroom finished in black slate, and three doublebedrooms with underfloor heating throughout. The two larger bedrooms have built-in wardrobes and the wonderful use of glazing continues with access to the rear decked terrace.

The garden, in its maturity and dramatic contours, offers an overwhelming sense of secluded wilderness. Steps made from railway sleepers meander through the captivating landscape of the steep decline to an insulated and drylined summer house with picture window and sliding doors to a decked area looking out over a stream at the foot of the garden.

The house, which is super-insulated, operates an air source heat pump, MVHR unit (mechanically ventilated heat recovery unit), and employs a rainwater harvesting system.

Hillside Road, on which the property is located, is less than 100 metres from St Helen's Wood, a 104-acre nature reserve of ancient woodland and wildflower meadows. It is within walking distance of Ore railway station, from which trains to London take approximately 1 hour 50 minutes. Hastings railway station is also a short drive away, from where more regular direct trains run to London (journey time to Charing Cross 1 hour 30 minutes). The house is approximately two miles from the seafront and central Hastings. Nearby Hastings Old Town provides a good range of shops and cafes and there is green space at the popular Alexandra Park nearby.

The East Sussex coast is well known not only for its beaches (Pett Level and Winchelsea being perhaps the best beaches in the Hastings area) but also for its thriving arts scene. The De La Warr pavilion in Bexhill, an iconic Modernist building, has a renowned arts programme and, in Hastings itself is the Jerwood Gallery.
