Quernmore Road

This incredibly bright two-bedroom apartment occupies the upper level of an end-of-terrace Victorian conversion on Quernmore Road, a quiet, tree-lined residential street approximately one minutes' walk from Harringay station.

The property is accessed via a side staircase from the ground floor. The main living space has been reconfigured by the current owners to provide one long open-plan kitchen, dining area and sitting room, with stripped-wood flooring and a working open fireplace. A total of 11 windows and roof lights flood the apartment with natural light and offer excellent views across the foliage of neighbouring gardens to the city beyond.

There are two double bedrooms, one behind sliding pocket doors from the sitting room. The second has plenty of eaves storage and contains a utilities cupboard. Both benefit from roof lights overhead. The bathroom is situated on the first floor.

Quernmore Road is a quiet residential street within a short walk of the shops and restaurants of Crouch End Broadway, and the bustling Green Lanes. Finsbury Park provides expansive areas of green space, and the wonderful Parkland Walk is a wooded 2.5-mile disused railway line that runs to Highgate. Harringay station is a stones' throw away and has regular trains to Highbury and Islington (Victoria Line) taking approximately seven minutes, and Old Street (Northern Line) in around 13 minutes.
