This engaging modern townhouse stands adjacent to Waterlow Park, and enjoys treetop views over Highgate's Victorian cemetery.

Accommodation measures 1,514 sq ft. The living space is arranged on the top floor, where an open-plan reception, kitchen and dining area gives on to a roof terrace. The top floor is triple-aspect, and therefore flooded with light. The first floor contains two double bedrooms and two bathrooms. There are two garages on the ground floor, as well as a utility room.

The house was designed by Bere Architects, a small but imaginative practice run by Justin Bere. They have devised a gently twisting structure that opens up towards the winter sun, with an overhanging roof canopy that controls the summer heat gain.
